Membership Benefits

The most important CNSV membership benefit is a website skills profile, which may include a photo and logo. Profiles are searchable by site visitors looking for skilled consultants, and can be easily updated by way of a site login. Membership also includes a subscription to a member email listserver, as well as email receipt of projects posted to our site.

Becoming a Member

At \$100 for the first year and \$50 for each year thereafter, CNSV is a great value. To apply for membership, send in a check along with the application form available on the CNSV website. IEEE membership is not required for CNSV membership.

Finding a Consultant

Our website features two tools for finding a consultant. The first is the Consultant Search, which searches for your requested keywords and skill sets within the profiles of our entire membership. The second search tool is the Project Bank, which allows website visitors to submit a detailed description of a consulting job. Project Bank submissions are forwarded to our membership.

Free Monthly Meetings

CNSV monthly meetings are held in Santa Clara, and are free to the membership and the public. Preceded by a member marketing meeting, they feature speakers covering technical and marketing topics deemed important or interesting to consultants.
